Submissions

Submit all ads and requests to **WebMD Ad Submission** at ads@webmd.net with the containing information in the subject line:

- Client name
- Brand or product name
- Name of WebMD sales contact
- Optionally include additional information within the body (i.e., nature of request (e.g., creative replacement)

Lead Time

Up to **5 business days** from date of request for testing, revisions, and implementation.

Additional Guidelines:

- Creative must have a distinct border to clearly identify where the page ends and advertisement begins.
- Click-through URLs must open in a new browser window.
- Expandable ad units
 - Expansion must be initiated by mouseover or click. Mouseover must be held in place for 1 second before expansion.
 - Ad must collapse when mouse is moved off expanded section.
 - Expandable ad units must have a prominent "Close X" button in the corner of the original ad unit or expanded panel.
- Approved third party servers include, but not limited to:
 - DFA, Medialets, MediaMind, Phluent, Pointroll
 - No DFA Internal Redirects are accepted
 - Tags must be in JavaScript or HTML5
- HTML5 accepted if served by approved 3rd party vendor.
 - Third party ad server must detect HTML5 compatibility and automatically serve non-HTML5 creative to browsers that do not support HTML5.
- Third party servers not listed must be reviewed by WebMD.

Audio/Video Guidelines:

- All audio/video ads must be 3rd party served.
- Sound/video must be user-tap-initiated.
- A clearly marked option for muting sound and pausing video must be included for the entire duration.
