MEDICARE'S ANNUAL ELECTION PERIOD



WHAT IS IT?

Medicare's annual election period (AEP) is the window of time each year when Medicare enrollees can change, switch, or drop plans as needed.

WHEN IS IT?

You can make changes from Oct. 15 – Dec. 7 each year. And any change in coverage begins Jan. 1.

WHAT CAN I CHANGE?

DURING AEP, YOU CAN:

- Switch from Medicare Advantage to Original Medicare or vice versa.
- Switch from one Medicare Advantage plan to another.
- Join, drop, or switch a Part D prescription plan.

WHEN ELSE CAN I MAKE CHANGES?

- Medicare Advantage enrollees can make one change, either to a different plan or back to Original Medicare, from Jan. 1 – March 31.
- If you live in an area with a 5-star plan, you can switch to it any time between Dec. 8 Nov. 30.
- Any time during the first year you're enrolled in Medicare Advantage, you can switch to an Original Medicare plan.
